What is “Associate Membership”?

Associate Membership is a subscription to The Psychological Society of Ireland (PSI, the professional association of Psychologists in Ireland) which is available to all who wish to join the PSI as an Associate Member.

Applicants are requested to note that acceptance of a candidate for Associate Membership of The Psychological Society of Ireland does not automatically confer eligibility for Graduate Membership of that Society.

What are my entitlements as a Associate Member of PSI?

As an Associate Member, you will receive access to a monthly bulletin (**The Irish Psychologist**) and regular details of Psychology news, lectures, meetings and social events. Reductions in fees to the PSI Annual Conference and other meetings and events are also available to Associate Members.

Am I eligible for Associate Membership?

Associate Membership is available to people who are not eligible for Graduate Membership; for example, you cannot be an Associate Member if you possess an honours degree or equivalent in Psychology from a recognised institution or if you are studying on an accredited psychology degree course. If you are unsure of your eligibility, please provide full details of any qualifications in Psychology which you have already obtained. Associate Membership is valid for one year and can be renewed on a yearly basis.

How much does it cost?

The annual fee for Associate Membership is **€55.00**. Your application will not be processed by PSI if this fee is not enclosed with the completed form overleaf.
